

LIVESTOCK FORAGE DISASTER PROGRAM (LFP)

- Provides payments to eligible producers of a grazed forage crop on private land, such as native or improved pastureland that has suffered grazing losses due to a qualifying drought.
- Available for producers in areas experiencing D2 drought conditions for at least eight consecutive weeks or D3 or worse drought conditions at any time.
- Provide a completed application and required supporting documentation to your FSA office within 30 calendar days after the end of the calendar year in which the grazing loss occurred.

EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE FOR LIVESTOCK, HONEYBEES & FARM-RAISED FISH PROGRAM (ELAP)

- Provides payments for losses due to eligible adverse weather conditions, including (but not limited to) water shortages and wildfires.
- Covers losses resulting from the additional cost of transporting water and feed to livestock as well as transporting livestock to available forage.
- Available for producers in areas experiencing D2 drought conditions for at least eight consecutive weeks or D3 or worse drought conditions at any time.
- Producers must also submit a "Notice of Loss" to their FSA office within 30 days of the loss.

NONINSURED CROP DISASTER ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (NAP)

- Helps producers manage risk through coverage for both crop losses and crop planting that was prevented due to natural disasters.
- Eligible crops include agricultural commodities not covered by federal crop insurance.
- Producers must be enrolled in the program and have purchased coverage for the eligible crop in the crop year the loss was incurred to receive program benefits following a qualifying natural disaster.
- Contact FSA for coverage costs and dates.
