## WILDFIRE DISASTER ASSISTANCE FOR CALIFORNIA RANCHERS AN OVERVIEW OF USDA PROGRAMS PROVIDING WILDFIRE ASSISTANCE

#### **LIVESTOCK LOSSES**

#### LIVESTOCK INDEMNITY PROGRAM (LIP)

- Reimburses producers up to 75 percent of the market value of animals lost due to adverse weather conditions. Adverse weather conditions under LIP include wildfires.
- All classes of cattle are eligible for reimbursement including cows, bulls and calves.
- Provide a completed application and required supporting documentation to your FSA office within **30 calendar days** of when the loss of livestock is first apparent and file an application for payment within **60 calendar days after the end of the calendar year** in which the eligible loss condition occurred.

#### **FORAGE LOSSES**

### EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE FOR LIVESTOCK, HONEY BEES AND FARM-RAISED FISH (ELAP) & LIVESTOCK FORAGE PROGRAM (LFP)

- Both programs provide assistance to producers who experience grazing loss due to adverse weather conditions including wildfire.
- ELAP can provide assistance for grazing loss from wildfire on non-federal lands and LFP can provide assistance for grazing loss from wildfire on federal lands.
- Producers must submit applications to their local county FSA office within **30 calendar days** of the loss.

#### **NONINSURED CROP DISASTER ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (NAP)**

- Provides payments for loss of forage due to drought or other natural disasters such as wildfires.
- To be eligible to receive payments, ranchers must have previously enrolled in the program with their county FSA office and paid the service fee.
- Producers must report a loss to their local county FSA office within **15 calendar days of the natural disaster occurring** by completing a "Notice of Loss and Application for Payment" form.

#### **INFRASTRUCTURE LOSS**

#### **EMERGENCY CONSERVATION PROGRAM (ECP)**

- Assists ranchers with fence construction and repairing other rangeland infrastructure that may have been lost or damaged due to a natural disaster.
- Ranchers are eligible to receive up to 75 percent of the cost to implement the project.
- Contact your county FSA office to request federal funds for local restoration projects.

#### **ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY INCENTIVE PROGRAM (EQIP)**

- Assists ranchers with fence construction and repairing other rangeland infrastructure that are not eligible for assistance under other federal disaster assistance programs.
- Applications for projects can be taken by your NRCS representative at your local County FSA office.
